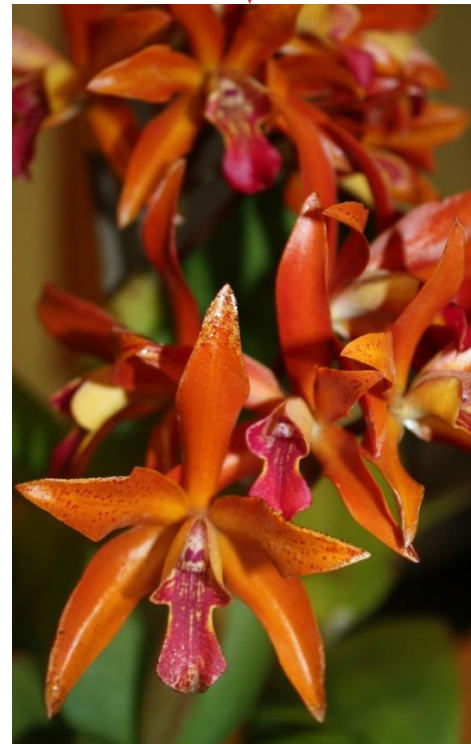
JULY MEETING SPEAKER
